1-Net Singapore Announces Expansion Plans

Data center solutions provider 1-Net plans to expand its telco-class Tier 3 Internet data center facilities in Singapore to meet growing regional demands for outsourced IT services.

1-Net will add approximately 20,000 square feet of hosting space to its existing 80,000 square feet data center facility at Chai Chee. The center will offer a complete suite of managed services such as systems management, backup and storage management, managed security and monitoring.

In 2010, its Tier 4 data center will feature the latest green technologies in an independent building. In line with its expansion plans, the company also plans to hire more IT professionals.

1-Net recently became a member of ADCA – a four-member alliance that provides a common channel for companies in Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand and Vietnam to access services that are compliant with international standards and transfer digital content media seamlessly across borders.
