### **1-Net Singapore expands to meet growing customer demands**

1-Net Singapore announced its plan to expand its telco-class Tier 3 Internet Data Center, fully-integrated with a complete suite of managed services to cater to growing demands for outsourced IT services throughout Southeast Asian markets.

1-Net will add approximately 20,000 square feet of hosting space to its existing 80,000 square feet data center located at Chai Chee in the coming six months. Moreover, 2010 will mark 1-Net Singapore's new Tier 4 data center adopting the latest green technologies in its own independent building. During the expansion, 1-Net will be hiring additional IT professionals.

The expanded capacity will also allow more businesses to take advantage of 1-Net's status as a carrier-neutral data center with the ability to provide zero mile access to the Internet via its multi-homed internet exchange, as well as the broadband network on Gigabit Ethernet (GE) platform that interconnects the majority of broadband traffic within 1-Net premises.
